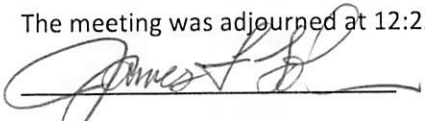


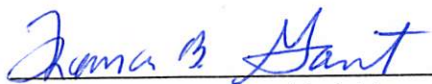
A Center Township Board Meeting was held on February 12th, 2026 at the Deerhead Cafe. In attendance were Trustee Gary Burdsall, J. Stucki, Tom Gant, and James Tolen. The meeting started at 12:05, was video recorded, and ended at approximately 12:25.

1. Minutes from the January 6, 2026, Township Board meeting were distributed and discussed. Tom Gant moved for acceptance, and J. Stucki seconded the motion. The minutes were signed by the Trustee, Tom Gant, J. Stucki, and James Tolen.
2. Resolution to Approve the Rental/Vendor Agreement. The Trustee presented the agreement for review. The limit on the amount of annual relief per resident was increased from \$800 to \$1,000. All members approved and signed the resolution.
3. Standards and Guidelines for 2026. The Trustee presented the Standards and Guidelines for review. Jim Tolen moved to accept the Standards and Guidelines. Tom Gant seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously. All members signed the resolution.
4. The Annual Report and Capital Assets for 2025 were not complete at the time of our meeting, and was tabled.
5. There was discussion concerning the Negley Cemetery. It was brought to the Trustees attention that the Negley Cemetery, on Weaver Road had not had any burials since 1940. Therefore, it is defined as a Burial Ground instead of a Cemetery. Burial Grounds allow an easement next to a public road, and so the fiber optics cable that was placed through the Burial Grounds within the easement of Weaver Road is allowed. We are asking the utility to remove any above ground structures within the Burial Grounds, and we will allow the conduit, which is already in place to remain. The members of the Township did not want to allow any more subsurface disturbance. Jim Tolen moved that the Township post corner posts on the east side of Weaver Road, fence in the cemetery at approximately eight to ten feet off the side of the road, leaving a gate for access to equipment for mowing, fill any low spots, seed and mulch the cemetery, and maintain the cemetery as needed, including mowing. Tom Gant seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

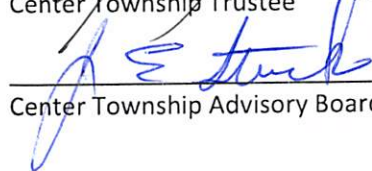
The meeting was adjourned at 12:25 PM.
